#### **Articles**

#### Article 1

(1) The competition will be held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., the General competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland and these Supplementary Regulations, including the appendix 25, 29, 31 of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook. All competitors who forward completed Entry form agree to be bound by these rules.

#### Article 2
