Please note the following:

1. Reconnaissance Sign-On, on Saturday / Sunday 27th/28th Oct. will be based in the **Wallis Arms Hotel** Millstreet from 08:00 – 12:00.
Reconnaissance on Thursday/Friday 2nd / 3rd Oct. will be based in the rally office at the **Green Glens Complex**. from 08:00 – 12:00.
2. Mechanical Scrutiny and Trailer Park are based at the Green Glens Complex in Millstreet Co Cork. We would ask that competitors attend Documentation Scrutiny immediately after completing Mechanical scrutiny so as to avoid lengthy delays later.
3. Documentation scrutiny will take place in the Rally office in the Green Glens Complex from 14:30-19:00 on Friday 3rd. Oct.
4. Parc Ferme is based in the Green Glens Complex Millstreet Co Cork,
When leaving the scrutiny hall, you have the option of driving directly into Parc Ferme or returning to the trailer park.

ALL CARS MUST BE IN PARC FERME BY 22:00 Fri. 3rd OCT.

5. Due out times from Parc Ferme will be posted on the Official Notice Board by 22:00 Friday 3rd October.

Reece:

6. Reece will **ONLY** be permitted between the hours of 09:00 – 18:00
7. Reece stickers must be displayed prominently on cars at all times – this will be monitored for compliance.
8. Reece: Temporary Suspension: Due to the advent of pre-arranged local community activities and school finishing times, Reece will be temporarily suspended on the following stages, at dates and times indicated below.
SS 8/11/14: Thurs/Fri 2nd / 3rd Oct: Reece prohibited between 09:00 to 09:30 & from 14:00 to 15:30. This restriction must be strictly adhered to and will be monitored by judge of facts.
9. Speed limit on stages for reece 60kph. Please note there will be radar speed checks on the route **DO NOT IGNORE !!**
Please respect local residents. Penalties will be applied. Please drive carefully as Garda speed checks will also be in place along the route.
10. Requests for reseeding in writing only on Official Headed Paper **before** 6pm on Friday 3rd October. Requests can be made at Reece Sign-On.
11. Drivers briefing will be held in the Green Glens complex at 08:15 SHARP on Saturday 4th October. It is mandatory that crews attend briefing, Roll calls may be made & penalties applied for any absentees.
12. **THE USE OF CHASE CARS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN AND WILL BE STRICTLY MONITORED. PENALTIES WILL APPLY. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTION TO THIS RULE.**
13. Please note there will be **NO REFUELLING RIG** in operation during the rally.
14. Competitors and Service Crews **MUST** remove litter from the Service Areas.
Skips will be provided in the Service - **PLEASE USE THEM** – Should Service Crews ignore this instruction penalties may be applied to the relevant competitors at the discretion of the organisers.
15. All service crews must have ground sheets. If your service crew do not adhere to this instruction they will not be permitted in the service area, this also applies to Trailer Park. Failure to comply with this instruction may result in penalties being applied.

- 16. PLEASE NOTE:** In order to speed up documentation scrutiny, we will be collecting Competition Licences from both the driver and navigator at Recce sign on – these will be returned at documentation scrutiny on Friday 3rd. October. We will also be collecting the IRDS loading at recce. This should greatly improve the queues at documentation scrutiny.

- 18.** Rally 2: The event will have available to competitors Rally 2 regulations, please ensure you read and fully understand the rules and regulations of re-joining under rally 2 regulations – please refer to relevant Section 8 of the regulations (page 16-17). A dedicated Rally 2 co-ordinator has been appointed to assist and monitor compliance with the re-start procedures. Greg Shinnors (087-2691975) is the nominated co-ordinator and all enquires / re-start requests to be directed to him.
- 19.** Junior Drivers Briefing will take place at 08:15hrs on Saturday 4th October in the Green Glens Complex. Attendance at the drivers briefing is compulsory and attendance roll calls may be made and non-attendance may result in penalties being applied. The Asst. C.O.C. for Juniors will be John Ward (086-6030121).
- 20.** The event Scrutineers will be carrying out spot checks at stage starts and will pay particular attention to the proper fastening of safety harnesses and wearing of Hans Devices.
- 21.** The onus is on competitors to ensure they are entered in the correct class.
