1. The event will **start** on Saturday at 12.00 a.m., at the Industrial Park, Browns Road, Waterford. (Venue will be sign- posted from Cork Road, Waterford) The event will start on Sunday at 11.00 a.m. at the Industrial Park, Browns Road, Waterford

(All cars must complete FIRST LAP before 2<sup>nd</sup> Lap can start, as test's maybe altered) <u>Check in will open at 11.00 hrs. Saturday start at 12.00hrs, & 10.00 hrs. Sign on &</u> <u>start 11.00 hrs. Sunday</u>

ALL TESTS MUST FINISH BY 1600 HRS EACH DAY

### Penalty of 5 Seconds for Late starting tests

 Competitors must hold a 2018 Competition License. This must be available for inspection at the start. One-Day License will be available (must notify club one week before)

3. The tests will be designed to suit all types of cars equally. TESTS IN ALL HEWISON CHAMPIONSHIP AUTOTESTS WILL BE MUCH MORE SUITABLE FOR ROAD-GOING AND MULTI VENUE CARS THAN IN PREVIOUS YEARS. THEY WILL BE SHORTER, EASIER TO LEARN AND REMEMBER, AND MORE OPEN SO THAT DRIVERS IN CLASS F WILL BE ABLE TO ENJOY THEMSELVES.

- 4. The time taken for each test will be taken as being the penalty for that test. Additional Penalties may be incurred as follows:
  - (a) Each initial contact with a pylon -
  - (b) Each line fault.

5 seconds.5 seconds

- All lines during a test to be crossed by a cars leading
  Wheels only. I.e. astride all lines, with a line fault penalty
  Of 5 seconds for putting more than two wheels, or only one wheel across
- 5. Maximum lose including failure, shall be the best correct performance <u>IN CLASS</u> on that test plus 20 seconds.
- 6 The only judges of fact for a particular test will be the marshals appointed for that test.
- 7. Ties will be decided by the better performance on the first test and so on Until the tie is resolved.
