The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes as necessary depending on the number of entries received.

All vehicles must be accompanied by a log book issued by Motorsport Ireland or by the MSA.

ENTRIES:

Entries Open on publication of these regulations.

The Entry Fee for the Main Field, Historic and Juniors is € 650 with an early €25 reduction as per App 32 Current MI Yearbook for paid entries received Wednesday week before the event. (This includes Motorsport Ireland Personal Accident Insurance, Standard Rate IRDS/BRDS Insurance and Fire extinguisher charge). The Entry Fee for J1000 Entry Fee is €400 including all levies etc

This Entry Fee's includes Motorsport Ireland Personal Accident Insurance, Standard Rate IRDS/BRDS Insurance and Fire extinguisher charge).

Competitors must ensure they hold the required valid competition licence as per below requirements and Proof of IRDS/BRDS cover must be available (on MI website database) at Documentation.

• NO LICENCE – NO START

• NO IRDS OR BRDS PROOF OF COVER- NO START

• NAVIGATOR LICENCE

- > IMPORTANT all co-drivers in Stage Rallies MUST hold a minimum of Navigator licence.
- MI Stage International, Stage National A, Stage National B and Road National B Drivers' licences <u>ARE VALID</u> for co-drivers.
- Because the MSA's grading system is different to MI's, MSA Stage International, Stage National A, Stage National B and Stage & Road Navigator <u>ARE ALL VALID</u> for co-drivers.



Only fully completed entry forms, accompanied by the Entry Fee will be accepted. The Club reserves the right to refuse an entry.

Supplementary Regulations

Article 1.

1.1 The competition will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, The General Competition Rule of Motorsport Ireland, these Supplementary Regulations and the Valvoline National Forest Rally Championship Regulation (Appendix 32). All competitors who forward a completed Entry Form agree to be bound by these rules.

Article 2.

- 2.1 The supplementary Regulations for the Rally are as stated by the Motorsport Ireland 2019 Yearbook and the Valvoline National Forest Rally Championship also in the 2019 yearbook.
- 2.2 Final Instructions form an integral part of these Supplementary Regulations.

Article 3.

3.1 The use of Forestry Lands for testing or practicing is prohibited, anyone found doing so on the stages to be used for this event will be refused a start and reported to Motorsport Ireland. All named Official are judges of fact, in this regard.

Article 4.

- 4.1 Safety notes will be allowed on this event. Competitors will not be allowed Recce the stages before the event.
- 4.2 Safety notes will be available from third parties on Friday 12th April 2019. The Club has no involvement in their preparation or sale and accepts no responsibility for the accuracy.

Article 5. (Rally 2 – Restart after Retirement)

5.1: General

5.1.1 The rally will operate Rally 2 in accordance with Art 13, Appendix 29 of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook (as published on MI Website)

5.1.2 A crew retiring from the rally between Parc Ferme Out and Arrival Control SS2, may restart the rally from Service Out Control after 2 stages, or Service Out Control after 4 stages (subject to compliance with 5.3.1 below).

Cars retiring from the rally on Special Stages 2 or 3, or the following road sections, may restart from Service Out Control after 4 stages or Service Out Control after 6 stages (subject to compliance with 5.3.1 below).

Cars retiring from the rally on Special Stages 4 or 5, or the following road sections, may only restart from Service Out Control after 6 stages.

No restart will be permitted for crews retiring on Special Stages 6, 7, or 8.

A restart will not be permitted where a crew has been excluded for non-compliance with eligibility requirements, traffic violations or a decision of the COC/R2C (Rally 2 Co-ordinator).



On retirement the crew must hand in their time cards to Car Accountability or the marshal/timekeeper at the next available location/Time Control.

Crews must retain the duplicate copy of the time card, to present to R2C as proof of stages completed.

5.1.3 Competitors must register for Rally 2 if they wish to restart by contacting the R2C prior to a time that will be specified in Final Instructions.

Service Vehicles will not be permitted to access the Stage or any closed road between runs. The organisers will, where possible, endeavour to remove any car to the nearest location where it can exit the stage.

The transport of the car from that location is the responsibility of the competitor. The car must return by direct route to the Service Area.

- **5.1.4** Competitors availing of Rally 2 must present themselves at the appropriate Out Control, with their car, for re-scrutiny. Due time is 10 minutes before their original due time at that Control, and 15 Minutes maximum lateness will apply.
- **5.1.5** The R2C, once satisfied that the crew meets the conditions for a restart, will issue new time cards which will have a restart time and restart Control Number.

The restart position within the field shall be at the discretion of the COC/R2C.

5.1.6 The organisers reserve the right to disallow restart on safety grounds or if the restart would interfere with the running of the rally.

5.2 Penalties:

5.2.1 Penalties will be applied as per Article 13.5, Appendix 29 of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook (as published on MI Website)

5.3 Award Eligibility:

- **5.3.1** In order to be classified as a finisher the crew must complete a minimum of 4 special stages, which must include the final loop of stages and the finish control.
- **5.3.2** Crews completing the rally under Rally 2 regulations **will** be eligible to score points in Championships.

Article 6.

- 6.1 Entries open on publication of the regulation.
- 6.2 Entries close on Wednesday 3rd April 2019
