This is the final round of the Hyundai Limerick Motor Centre National Autocross Championship 2019 and a counting round of the Munster Autocross Championship & a round of the IMC Club Championship

Regulations

This event will be held under the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), Appendix 85.1, 85.2 & 87 of the 2019 Motorsport Ireland Yearbook (Green Book), these supplementary regulation and any other final instructions that may be issued. Motorsport Ireland Permit No. 19/138 has been issued for the event. The organizers have reserved the right to cancel or postpone the event or part of it in exceptional circumstances.

Venue – Carrigatogher, Midleton, Co. Cork.

The event takes place on private property at Carrigatogher, Midleton by kind permission of Mr. James Cotter. The venue will be arrowed from the “Two Mile Inn” east of Midleton on the N25 main Waterford – Cork Rd.

Unofficial practice, failure to pass scrutiny or late arrival will lead to exclusion. All cars must comply with appendix 2 of the 2019 M.I Yearbook-Scrutiny requirements. A maximum of 3 drivers per car will be allowed but the onus will be on the competitors to have the correct competition number clearly displayed. The club accepts no responsibility for mistakes in timing due to the wrong number being displayed.

Classes:

Class 1 Saloons and Sports Cars up to 1450cc with engine over driven wheels.

Class 2 Saloons and Sports Cars 1451cc to 1650cc with engine over driven wheels.

Class 3 All other Saloons and Sports Cars to 1650cc.

Class 4 Saloons and Sports Cars over 1651cc with engine over driven wheels.

Class 5 All other Saloons & Sports Cars not qualifying for Class 1 to 4 . Super Saloons & all 4WD Cars will run in this Class.

Class 6 Motorcycle Engined Specials over 1250cc up to 1400cc Maximum. Only open to competitors 18 years and over.

Class 7 Car Engined Specials. Only open to competitors 18 Years and over.

Class 8 “Intermediate class” for 16-18 year olds, holding a “Speed National B” licence in Saloon cars up to 1650cc

Class 9 “Junior Class” for 14-16 year olds holding a “Junior” Licence in Saloon Cars up to 1450cc.

Class 10 Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies up to 600cc. Only open to competitors 18 Years and over.

Class 11 Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies from 601cc to 1000cc. Only open to competitors 18 years and over

Class 12 Motorcycle Engined Specials 751cc to 1249cc. Only open to competitors 18 years and over

Notes on Classes: Maximum Engine Capacities are as Follows: Motorcycle Engine Buggy is 1000cc, Motorcycle Engine Special is 1400cc, Car Engine Special is 4000cc.

The onus rests with the competitor to enter a class for which their car is eligible. Classes are final at scrutiny.



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Entries are open on publication of these regulations. All drivers must be in possession of a current 2019 competitions licence and vehicle logbook which must be produced at scrutiny. All competition vehicles must pass SCRUTINY. Safety equipment MUST include a safety harness and a securely fitted 1.75 Kg minimum AFFF (or FIA Approved equivalent.) Fire Extinguisher. Helmets and protective clothing must comply with standards set out in Appendices 2 & 3 for autocross events in the 2019 Yearbook.

The track will be marked with flags and arrows. A penalty of 5 seconds will be incurred for striking or passing on the wrong side of a standing Red marker. Claims for Baulking must be made at the end of the run in which it occurred. Dangerous driving and Unruly Behavior will be dealt with by the COC. The official Timekeepers, Officials and Flag Marshall's will be Judges of Fact and will be deemed to be Correct at all times. The appropriate fee must accompany protests.

Awards will be presented to FTD: Fastest Time of the Day Saloon Driver (Classes 1-4) Fastest Super Saloon Car Driver (Class 5) and Fastest Special/Buggy Driver (Class 6, 7 & 10). 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class and 1st, 2nd & 3rd Ladies along with Novice and best IMC DRIVER. Other awards at the clubs discretion.
