- 13. Navigators may get their Roadbook at Documentation Scrutiny without needing the Driver to be present. <u>Timecards & Car Numbers will be withheld until both crew members have all Paper & Mechanical Scrutiny Complete.</u>

- 15. Competitors are reminded to refer to the 2019 Yearbook and subsequent amendments to found on the M.I website with regards to correct usage of tyres. NO GRAVEL/FORESTRY TYRES ALLOWED.
