Dear Competitor,

Thank you for your entry to the **TF Royal Hotel & Theatre/ Casey/Mulroy Londis Mayo Stages Rally 2020**. Your entry has been accepted and you have been seeded as per the Seeded Entry List available on the club website, www.mayomotorsportclub.com.

Please note the following points:

The event H.Q. is the TF Royal Hotel & Theatre, Castlebar, Co. Mayo
GPS. N 53° 51' 11" W 009° 18' 13"

**Parking of trailers is strictly forbidden in front of the hotel or in the hotel car park. A trailer park is provided close to the Service Area. Please do not park trailers or service vehicles along the road in front of the Hotel and please do not carry out any servicing in this area.
We thank you for your co-operation.**

GARDA SPEED CHECKS WILL BE ENFORCED THROUGHOUT THE WEEKEND.

1. Entries/Documentation:

2.1 There will be no Scrutineering or Sign on available on Sunday morning.

Please note that IRDS/BRDS insurance will only apply for the Rally Route, the Scrutineering Route is detailed in the event Roadbook

2. Reconnaissance:

Drivers must have their IRDS / BRDS insurance completed at reconnaissance sign on.

Please ensure Reconnaissance Stickers are displayed prominently on the top corner of the windscreen **BEFORE** commencing reconnaissance.

Please Note Art 4.5 to Art 4.7 Appendix 29 of MI Yearbook 2020 in relation to Reconnaissance

Judges of Fact will patrol the Rally Route during Recce and on Rally Day. The decision of a Judge of Fact will be final.

3. Scrutineering:

Mechanical Scrutineering will take place at Casey's Garage, Turlough Road, Castlebar.

GPS: N 53° 52' 02" W 009° 17' 13"

Parc Ferme is located at the Multi Storey Car Park on Old Westport Road adjacent to Rally HQ. GPS : N 53° 51' 13" W 009° 18' 21"

Unloading of cars is to take place at the trailer park **only**.

Please follow the instructions of the Marshals in this regard to avoid congestion to businesses in that area. Unloading of cars is prohibited at the Scrutiny Area.

The driving of competing cars outside of the specified route after Scrutineering may lead to exclusion. Please present cars ready for scrutiny in accordance with Appendices 2, 25, 29 & 29.1 of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook 2020, with decals attached and the scrutiny sheet completed. The Safety Tracker System must be fitted prior to attending Scrutineering

4. Trailer Park:

The trailer park will be located at Elvery's Car Park, Moneen Road, Castlebar.

GPS: N 53° 51' 23" W 009° 16' 19"

5. Safety Tracking System.

A Safety Tracking System will operate on the rally. Collection, installation and operation of the system will be advised in a separate Final Instruction. **The Safety Tracking System must be fitted to the car before attending Scrutineering.**

6. Start of the Rally:

At least one member of the crew **MUST** attend the Competitors Safety Briefing (Appendix 25 Art 3.2) at 07:45 on Sunday Morning 8th March at Rally HQ, TF Hotel & Theatre, Castlebar. There will be a random roll call. A 2 minute penalty may be applied for not attending.

Start of the rally will be at Control 0 Start Ramp in front of TF Royal Hotel & Theatre.

Cars will be released from Parc Ferme in their start order 5 mins before their due time at the Start Control and must proceed directly to the Start Control following the route in the road book.

7. Junior Rally (Class 16).

Junior Rally crews will run in the main field over stages 1 to 6.

8. Service

Service Stickers will be supplied in the Competitors Pack at Documentation Scrutiny.

The Service Area is located at Breaffy Road Business Park, Castlebar.

GPS: N 53° 50' 51" W 009° 16' 48"

The Service Area will open at 7.15 am on Sunday morning.

Where multiple cars need to be serviced from the one service vehicle it is advisable to contact the **Service Area Co-ordinator, Ronan Murphy Phone No 087 2250121**, to arrange your location.

Please Note: A 5m x 4m ground sheet must be used for servicing and any oil spills must be cleaned up promptly. All waste must be disposed of in bins provided.

Please familiarise yourself with the fire requirements for the Service Area as per App 25.10.2 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook.

9. Finish of the Rally:

The finish of the rally will be TC 9A Finish Ramp in front of Rally Headquarters for Main Field and Historic competitors. On leaving the finish ramp, crews must follow the road book to Parc Fermé where their entry will be recorded by an official.

The Junior Rally will finish at TC6J Finish Ramp, in front of Rally Head Quarters and on leaving the finish ramp, crews must follow the route in the road book to Parc Ferme.

Provisional Results: Provisional Results will be posted on the Official Notice Board at 18:15

10. Rally 2 (Restart after Retirement):

The rally will operate Rally 2 in accordance with Art 13, Appendix 29 of the 2020 Motorsport Ireland Yearbook (as published on MI Website)
