Where in any event there are less than three championship Registered Starters for each Class, the points will be allocated subject to these Regulations for each Championship Class, whether or not the Class has been amalgamated on the event and will be reduced as follows:

A driver may nominate one vehicle and class for scoring on each event, Points will not be transferable from class to class.

#### If a competitor Changes classes during the Championship - they must inform the registrar and re-register in that class.

Priority will be given to the 1st 2nd & 3rd Overall and 1st 2nd & 3rd in Class at each round provided your completed entry complies with the regs.

#### Article 7

Ties will be resolved as follows:

- 1. In favour of the Competitor who achieves the greatest number of points in the overall championship.
- 2. In favour of the Competitor with the greatest number of Class wins in the five rounds.
- 3. In favour of the Competitor with the greatest number of second in class in the five rounds, failing that the third highest in class in the six rounds, and so on until the tie is broken.
- 4. Should the provision above not resolve the tie, then consideration will be given in favour of the Competitor who achieves her/his highest overall position in her/his first round of the series, failing this the second round, and so on until the tie is broken.
- 5. If the above fails to resolve a tie, the organising committee will decide the winner.

# south east stages 2011

The Championship is being promoted by The Carlow Car Club, The Carrick-on-Suir Motor Club, the Tipperary Car & Motor Cycle Club, Munster Car Club and Wexford Motor Club. The above five clubs will be hereafter referred to as the promoters of the Championship.

#### Article 2

Article 1

If through force majeure any of the above dates are altered, or an event is cancelled, the promoters of the Championship reserve the right to either accept a change of date, substitute a nominated event, cancel that particular round, add an extra event, or alter the number of events on which scores will count.

Any amendment to these Regulations will be numbered bulletins, which will be an extension, and have the same force as these Regulations.

The Championship will at all times be run under these Regulations, the G.C.R.s of the Motorsport Ireland / R.I.A.C. and the supplementary Regulations for each event in the series.

#### <u>Article 3</u>

Competitors are required to register for the Championship before the start of their first qualifying round, registration fee €40 per crew (Juniors €10 per crew), in applying for Registration, Competitors agree to be bound by these Regulations and amendments subsequently issued.

#### COMPETITORS MUST START AT LEAST THREE EVENTS TO QUALIFY FOR AN AWARD

#### Article 4

The Championship will be divided into the following classes.

- Class 1 All Cars up to 1450 c.c.
- Class 2 All Cars from 1451 c.c. to 1700 c.c., with two valves per cylinder.
- Class 3 All Cars from 1451 c.c. to 1700 c.c., more than two valves per cylinder.
- Class 4 All Cars from 1701 c.c. to 2400 c.c., with two valves per cylinder.
- Class 5 All Cars from 1701 c.c. to 2400 c.c., more than two valves per cylinder.
- Class 6 All Cars 2401 c.c. and over plus Turbo charged and 4 wheel drive.

Junior Awards - Only competitors entered in the Junior section of the events are eligible for this award, and will not be eligible for other class awards or overall awards.

The eligibility scrutineer for the championship is Pat O' Dowd, in the event of his non attendance he will nominate a replacement.
