Mechanical Scrutiny.

Mechanical Scrutiny takes place at Scariff Plant Hire in the Rosehill Commercial Centre in Ballinacurra, on Friday July 27th from 16:00hrs to 21:00hrs sharp. There will be no slot times.

Trailer park.

A trailer park will be available from 15:30hrs on Friday 27th in Colman's Yard in Ballinacurra. There will be no security on the trailer park and trailers can be parked here at the owner's discretion. Imokilly Motor Club and Colman Bros accept NO responsibility for trailers at any time during the event. Absolutely No Trailers allowed in the car park of Rally HQ.

Documentation Scrutiny.

You must attend Documentation Scrutiny at Rally HQ as soon as you have passed Mechanical Scrutiny and no later than 21:30hrs.

Competitors must ensure they are entered in the correct class before the start of the event. If you are classified incorrectly you may find yourself excluded from the results.

Parc Ferme

Parc Ferme will be located at the rear of Rally HQ. All cars must be presented at Parc Ferme by 21.30hrs Sharp on Friday July 27th. A starters list will be derived from cars presented at Parc Ferme.

Competitor Safety Briefing.

A Competitor Safety Briefing will take place at 07:30hrs on Saturday July 28th in Rally HQ *(not 08:00hrs as stated in the event regulations)*. It is compulsory for both crew members to attend.

Safety notes.

Please familiarise yourself with *Article 6 of the supplementary regulations* in relation to safety notes and the reconnaissance run. This will be strictly enforced.

Original safety notes are compulsory on this event and will be available to purchase from third parties between 07:00hrs and 09:00hrs only on Saturday July 28th. The Promoters have no involvement with their preparation or sale and accept no responsibility for their accuracy or otherwise. Please see the July issue of the Motorsport Ireland bulletin for a list of authorised safety note suppliers. Amendments to the original safety notes (*Appendix 29 Art 4.13.1*) can be made during the reconnaissance run on Saturday July 28th between the hours of 08.30hrs and 10.30hrs in accordance with the regulations. There is NO RESTRICTIONS on the amendments that can be made to the original safety note. <u>Amendments cannot be made prior to the commencement of the Reconnaissance Run</u>. Pace note checks will take place during this event. In respect of this, competitors are requested to familiarise themselves with *Appendix 29 Article 4.14 to Article 5.8 of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook 2012*.

Reconnaissance.

Competitors will be allowed one reconnaissance run only on Saturday July 28th between the hours of 08.30hrs and 10.30hrs. The reconnaissance run will be done in your road car. Following documentation scrutiny on Friday night a list will be posted on the official notice board at Rally Headquarters of allotted reconnaissance times. The onus is on the competitors to arrive at stage start at their due time for reconnaissance. A 2 minute penalty will apply for non compliance. This will be strictly enforced. Competitors will enter the stage on their reconnaissance run at 30 second intervals. Competitors are reminded that whilst parts of the stage will be set up during their reconnaissance run, the road will be still open to the public. The Maximum speed allowed on the stage during reconnaissance is 50 kph unless a lower limit is indicated by a traffic sign or a written instruction issued by the organisers. Traversing any part of the stage in the wrong direction is strictly forbidden. Judges of Fact will be monitoring the stage during the reconnaissance run.

Illegal Recce.

Imokilly Motor Club will not tolerate cheating of any sort. The stage will be policed by judges of fact at all times between now and July 28th. Please familiarise yourself with *Appendix 29 Article 4.8 to Article 4.11* of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook 2012 in relation to illegal reconnaissance. No excuses will be accepted.
