Thank you for your entry to the Mór Oil Galway Summer Rally 2012. Your seeded number is on the website, www.galwaymotorclub.ie and rally.ie.

Competitors Safety Briefing:

Time: 7.45am Sunday 26th August, 2012

Venue: Lough Rea Hotel & Spa, Loughrea.

It is compulsory for all competitors to attend Competitors Safety Briefing. To this end, 10 competitors will be drawn at random at the briefing, and any crews whose number is drawn, and who are not present (both crew members must be present), will incur a 2 minute penalty as per Appendix 25, 3.2. of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook 2012.

Sign-on for recce is available on Friday 24th August between 20.00 – 22.00 hrs<u>or</u>Saturday 25th August 08.00 – 12.00 hrs in the Lough Rea Hotel & Spa, Loughrea. (Rally HQ).

Pace note making is strictly from 08.30hrs - 17.00 hrs on Saturday 25th August.

We expect competitors to adhere to the maximum speed limit of 60kph during recce. Competitors are reminded that speed checks may be placed at random by the organisers and general patrols of the special stages will take place.

In relation to recce cars may we remind you that commercial vans i.e. Transit/Vito type vehicles cannot be used. Please ensure that recce stickers are displayed prominently on your vehicle prior to departure from the hotel car park. You are reminded that as per Appendix 29 Section 4.6.1 Reconnaissance is limited to a maximum of three passes per stage or any part thereof. The Organisers will have personnel in place at appropriate points along the route to police the rules of Recce.

<u>Mechanical Scrutiny:</u>

Please present your car for Mechanical Scrutiny at the Pauls Service Station, Athenry Road, Loughrea, Co. Galway. (Adjacent to HQ - The Lough Rea Hotel & Spa Mechanical Scrutiny will be open from 12.00hrs to 17.00hrs on Saturday 25th August 2012. Times for scrutiny will be posted on www.galwaymotorclub.ie and rally.ie. Please present your car at the requested time. Please note that the last 10 cars presented after 4pm (that is from 4pm to 5pm) will be used as a training session for Scrutineers - where they will be checked thoroughly by all Scrutineers. All cars must be in Parc Ferme and Competitors must have completed Paper Scrutiny <u>thirty minutes</u> after leaving mechanical scrutiny.

Documentation Scrutiny:

Documentation Scrutiny is at the Lough Rea Hotel & Spa from 12.30hrs to 17.30hrs on Saturday 25th August 2012 on Saturday Night Parc Ferme is The Loughrea Tyre Centre, Loughrea Co. Galway. The Trailer Park is located at the rear of The Loughrea Tyre Centre.

Door Decals and Mechanical Scrutiny Forms will be available at the Mechanical Scrutiny area. Decals must be on the car and you must have the first section of the Mechanical Scrutiny form completed **before** presenting the car for Mechanical Scrutiny.

Service Area:

All service vehicles must be in Service prior to 9am sharp on Sunday 26th August 2012 - there will be no exceptions. The service area will be open from 16.00hrs to 18.00hrs on Saturday 25th August. The Service Area is in the Livestock Mart, Loughrea.

No trailers are allowed in the service area by order of the COC. No trailers allowed at HQ or on the main road outside HQ at anytime. No unloading of competition cars will be tolerated around scrutiny.

Ground Sheets are required in the service area and frequent inspections of the use of Ground sheets will be carried out during the event by the Service Area Manager.

Final Control:

The Final Control after SS9 will be located at Service - The Mart. On Sunday evening the Parc Ferme will be located in the Service Area. The following competition cars are to proceed to the hotel after the final control. Cars numbers 1 to 10 inclusive, First GPN, First RWD, Top Galway Crew, Historics & Juniors.

Results:

Results will be posted 30 minutes after rally finish. Prize giving will be once results are final.

Licences must be handed in at recce sign-on. Competitors are reminded that it is <u>their</u> <u>responsibility</u> to ensure that their competition Licences and IRDS are in order <u>before</u> the weekend of the event. Competitors failing to present current competition licences and IRDS letter will not be allowed to start the event – without exception.
