Dear Competitor,

The 2014 Westlodge Hotel Fastnet Rally supported by Bantry Development and Tourism Association takes place on Sunday the 26th of October. Details of the schedule are included in these regulations.

This year, the rally is a counting round of the PlasticBags.ie Southern 4 Rally Championship and the Carbery Plastics Skibbereen and District Car Club Championship.

I welcome all competitors to the event. The rally will comprise of eight stages with a variety of fast flowing and tight twisty sections on both wide and narrow roads with a good tarmac surface. The rally will run over a loop of three stages, two of these stages being run three times and one stage being run twice. There will be generous service time available.

The chosen stages have never been run in this format and will be new to everybody. We have endeavoured to pick safe, flowing stages which will be challenging yet enjoyable. The event offers 135 stage kilometres with centralised servicing adjacent to Bantry town square.

The entry list will be published on the Skibbereen and District Car Club's web site (www.rally.ie.

Please use these facilities to answer any of your queries. A detailed time and distance schedule will be available on the two websites mentioned above. The co-operation of the residents along the route is a pre-requisite for the running of this event. Therefore, I would ask you to respect that co-operation and in particular I would ask you to drive carefully and to respect other road users during the recce period and off the stages on rally day.

We, in Skibbereen and District Car Club are very much aware that the competitor is in fact the customer and it is club policy to strive to make this an enjoyable event.

Please bear in mind that no official is paid and is working on behalf of the rally for the love of the sport. I look forward to seeing you for a safe and enjoyable rally weekend on the 25th and 26th of October.

ORGANISATION:

- 1. The Fastnet Rally is promoted and organised by Skibbereen & District Car Club Limited (hereinafter called the promoters).
- 2. These regulations have been submitted to and approved by Motorsport Ireland and the necessary permit for holding the competition has been granted. Permit No: 14/176
- 3. The Rally is a qualifying round of the following championships:

PlasticBags.ie Southern 4 Rally Championship Carbery Plastics Skibbereen & District Car Club Championship

4. The Rally will take place over a route of approximately 135 stage kilometres.

ARTICLE 1

The competition will be held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland and Appendices 25, 29 of the Motorsport Ireland 2014 Yearbook and these Supplementary Regulations. All competitors who forward completed entry forms agree to be bound by these rules.

ARTICLE 2

- 1. Pace Notes will be available for sale from third parties. The club has no involvement with their preparation or sale and accept no responsibility for their accuracy or otherwise.
- 2. Competitors may check and adjust their pace notes on Saturday 25th October between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm in accordance with regulations regarding the amount of passes.
- 3. Competitors making Pace Notes are obliged to register at Rally Headquarters, the Westlodge Hotel, Bantry between the hours of 8.00am and 11.00am on Saturday 25th. October.
- 4. You will be supplied with identification stickers, which must be placed on the front of the vehicle you are using where they are clearly visible. "Judges of Fact" will patrol the stages.
- 5. The maximum speed allowed on a stage during recce is 60 k.p.h. unless a lower limit is indicated by a traffic sign or a written instruction issued by the organisers. Traversing the stage in the wrong direction is expressly forbidden

ARTICLE 3

- 1. Entries open on the 18th September 2014.
- 2. Entries will be accepted either on line from **www.shannonsportsit.ie/evo**, or alternatively Print the full Entry form available from <u>www.shannonsportsit.ie/evo</u> or <u>www.skibbdcc.com</u>, complete and post to the address listed below. The indemnity

must be printed, signed and posted together with a cheque made payable to the Skibbereen & District Car Club. Failure to print and post the indemnity and cheque will result in an invalid entry.

RALLY 2 (RESTART AFTER RETIREMENT)

10.1: General

- **10.1.1** The rally will operate Rally 2 in accordance with Art 13, Appendix 29 of the 2014 Motorsport Ireland Yearbook (as published on MI Website)
- **10.1.2** A crew retiring from the rally between Parc Ferme Out and Arrival Control SS2 may restart the rally from Service B Out Control (Service Out Control before Stage 3), or Service C Out Control (Service Out Control before Stage 6).

Cars retiring from the rally on Special Stages 2, 3 or 4 or the following road sections may only re-start from Service C Out Control (Service Out Control before Stage 6).

No restart will be permitted for crews retiring on Special Stages 5, 6, 7 or 8.

On retirement the crew must hand in their Time Cards to Car Accountability or the marshal/timekeeper at the next available location/Time Control.

10.1.3 Competitors must register for Rally 2 if they wish to restart from Service B or from Service C by contacting the Rally 2 Co-Ordinator (R2C) prior to a time that will be specified in Final Instructions.

Service Vehicles will not be permitted to access the stage route between runs. The organisers will, where possible, endeavour to remove any car to the nearest location where it can exit the stage.

The transport of the car from that location is the responsibility of the competitor, the car must return by direct route to the Service Area.

- **10.1.4** Competitors availing of Rally 2 must present themselves at Service B Out control or Service C Out Control, with their car, for re-scrutiny. Due time is 10 minutes before their original due time at that Control, and 15 minutes maximum lateness will apply.
- **10.1.5** The R2C, once satisfied that the crew meets the conditions for a restart, will issue new timecards which will have a re-start time and re-start Control Number.

The restart position within the field shall be at the discretion of the COC/R2C.

10.1.6 The organisers reserve the right to disallow restart on safety grounds or if the restart would interfere with the running of the rally.

10.2 Penalties:

10.2.1 Penalties will be applied as per Article 13, Appendix 29 of the 2014 Motorsport Ireland Yearbook (as published on MI Website)

10.3 Award Eligibility:

- **10.3.1** In order to be classified as a finisher the crew must complete a minimum of four (4) special stages, which must include the final loop of stages and the finish control.
- **10.3.2** Crews completing the rally under Rally 2 regulations **will not** be eligible to score points in ANY Championship.
