Entries are open to all drivers whom hold a current competition license and log book, which must be produced at scrutiny.

Entry Fee: €100, Juniors and Intermediates €50 (AlInclude Competitors Personal Accident Insurance)

Entries to be received by Wednesday 24th August 2016.

Classes:

- 1: All Saloon cars up to 1450 c.c.
- 2: All Saloon cars from 1451 c.c.to 1650 c.c. with not more than 2 valves per cylinder
- 3: All Saloon cars from 1451 c.c.to 1650 c.c. with more than 2 valves per cylinder
- 4: All Saloon cars from 1651 c.c.to 2100 c.c.
- 5: All Saloon cars over 2100 c.c., 4WD cars and Turbocharged Saloon Cars.
- 6: Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies over 601cc. Only open to competitors 18 years and over.
- 7: Car Engined Specials. Only open to competitors 18 years and over.
- 8: "Intermediate class" for 16 18 year olds, holding a "Speed National B license in saloon cars up to 1650cc.
- 9: "Junior class" for 14 16 year olds, holding a "Junior" license in saloon cars up to 1450cc.
- 10: Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies up to 600cc. Only open to competitors 18 years and over.

- · All vehicles must pass scrutiny
- All vehicles must be fitted with fire extinguishers of an approved type
- All vehicles must be fitted with a full roll cage
- All saloon cars must be fitted with FIA (with no date limit) approved seats
- Fire resistant clothing must be worn as per Motorsport Ireland regulations
- Overhead / roof skid pans and side netting are compulsory on specials
- Seats, safety belts and helmets of an approved type must be used. See specification in current yearbook and latest MI bulletins

Timing:

Timing will be to 1/100th of a second from a flying start to a flying finish.

Awards:

- 1st, O/A Specials / Buggies
- 1st, O/A Saloons
- 1^{st, 2^{nd, 3rd} in each class}
- Best Beginner award
- Best Novice award

Winners of the overall award will not be eligible for class awards.

Additional awards may be presented.

Exclusion:

Competitors will be excluded from the results for the following offences.

- Failure to pass scrutiny.
- Failure to wear fireproof clothing (Balaclava, gloves, boots and socks), safety harness, crash helmet of the approved type while on the course.
- Failure to have the appropriate type of fire extinguisher in the car at all times during the event.
- Failure to obey a reasonable request from an official.
- Use of spikes, studs and chains are prohibited.

Penalties:

• 5 seconds for striking or passing on the wrong side of a penalty marker. In the case of a baulk only, penalties incurred in the first timed run will be carried forward to the re-run in all classes. Where penalty markers have been knocked down during a run and not replaced competitors are still required to follow the intended course, otherwise penalties as above will be applied. Penalty markers knocked after completion of a run will count.

Protests:

 Protests will only be accepted as per MI regulations. No case for force majeure will be considered once a competitor has started the event.
