1. Entries

- 1B: Cars built to Endurance Specification from 1001cc to 1400c.c.
- 2: Navigation Trial cars up to 1400 c.c.
- 3: Navigation Trial cars from 1401 to 2000 c.c.
- 4: Front Wheel Drive Retro type cars. (Retro cars as defined in Appendix 33)
- 5: Rear Wheel Drive Retro type cars. (Retro cars as defined in Appendix 33)

The Overall winner will be decided from Class 1 & 1B only.

3. Awards

General Classification: 1st; 2nd; 3rd Overall.

Class Awards: 1st, 2nd, 3rd in each class - 2 Trophies.

The award winners of the General Classification will not be eligible for a class award.

This policy document covers all those involved within the sport whether they are a Competitor, Entrant, Parent of a Competitor or Entrant, Team Official, Race Official or Motorsport Ireland Official whilst participating under Motorsport Ireland regulations regardless of their original national ASN. This policy is referred to in the entry forms for all events and is binding upon Competitors from other national ASNs in that manner.
- 2. Any content submitted online through the medium of the Internet by those participating or officiating at Motorsport Ireland sanctioned events should not contain material that could be deemed to be threatening, harassing, bullying, illegal, obscene, defamatory, slanderous or hostile towards any individual, team or entity participating or officiating at Motorsport Ireland sanctioned events or the Governing Body, Motorsport Ireland.
- 3. Content is defined as text, images, audio, video and any user generated content knowingly uploaded to the internet.
- 4.
