The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes as necessary depending on the number of entries received.

ALL vehicles must be accompanied by a logbook issued by Motorsport Ireland or MSA.

(See Appendix 32 of the 2017 MI Yearbook for class notes & championship regulations)

ENTRIES:

MAINFIELD: The entry fee is €550 plus MI Insurance Levy of €75 - Total Payable = €625

JUNIOR 1000: The entry fee is €325 plus MI Insurance Levy of €75 - Total Payable = €400

(This includes Motorsport Ireland Personal Accident Insurance, Standard IRDS/BRDS and Fire Extinguisher Levy.)

Late entries for both the main field and Junior 1000 will incur an additional fee of €25

Late Main field: €575 plus MI Insurance Levy of €75 - Total Payable = €650

Late J1000: €350 plus MI Insurance Levy of €75 - Total Payable = €425

Cheques should be made payable to: Donegal Motor Club Ltd.

The additional premium will be collected at documentation for any driver with Special Terms on the IRDS/BRDS database.

Proof of IRDS/BRDS cover must be available prior to sign-on through the MI database. The onus is on the competitor to ensure that his/her name is on the list prior to arriving at documentation.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS:

Article 1:

 The competition will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland, these supplementary regulations and the Valvoline National Forest Rally Championship Regulations. All competitors who forward a completed entry form agree to be bound by these rules.

Article 2:

- 1. The Supplementary Regulations for the competition are as stated by the Motorsport Ireland 2017 Yearbook and the Valvoline National Forest Rally Championship rules also in the 2017 Yearbook.
- 2. Final Instructions form an integral part of these Supplementary Regulations.

Article 3:

The use of Forestry Lands for testing or practicing is strictly prohibited. Anyone found doing so
on the stages to be used for this event, will be refused a start and reported to Motorsport
Ireland. All named officials are Judges of Fact, in this regard.

Article 4:

- 1. Safety notes will be allowed on this event. Competitors will not be allowed recce the stages before the event.
- 2. Safety notes will be available from third parties on Friday 12th May. The club has no involvement in their preparation or sale and accepts no responsibility for their accuracy.

Article 6:

- 1. Entries open upon publication of these Supplementary Regulations
- 2. Entries close on Friday 5th May 2017

Article 10:

10. Rally 2 (Restart after Retirement)

10.1: General

10.1.1 The rally will operate Rally 2 in accordance with Art 13, Appendix 29 of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook (as published on MI Website)

10.1.2 A crew retiring from the rally between Parc Ferme Out and Arrival Control SS3 may restart the rally from Service Out Control after 3 stages, or Service Out Control after 6 stages, providing that they comply with **10.3.1** below.

Cars retiring from the rally on Special Stages 3, 4 or 5, or the following road sections, may restart from Service Out Control after 6 stages or Service Out Control after 7 stages, providing that they comply with **10.3.1** below.

Cars retiring from the rally on Special Stage 6 or the following road section may only restart from Service Out Control after 7 stages. No restart will be permitted for crews retiring on Special Stages 7 or 8.

A restart will not be permitted where a crew has been excluded for non-compliance with eligibility requirements, traffic violations or a decision of the COC/R2C (Rally 2 Co-ordinator).

On retirement the crew must hand in their time cards to Car Accountability or the marshal/timekeeper at the next available location/Time Control.

Crews must retain the duplicate copy of the time card, to present to R2C as proof of stages completed.

10.1.3 Competitors must register for Rally 2 if they wish to restart by contacting the R2C prior to a time that will be specified in Final Instructions.

Service Vehicles will not be permitted to access the Stage or any closed road between runs. The organisers will, where possible, endeavour to remove any car to the nearest location where it can exit the stage.

The transport of the car from that location is the responsibility of the competitor. The car must return by direct route to the Service Area.

10.1.4 Competitors availing of Rally 2 must present themselves at the appropriate Out Control, with their car, for re-scrutiny. Due time is 10 minutes before their original due time at that Control, and 15 Minutes maximum lateness will apply.

10.1.5 The R2C, once satisfied that the crew meets the conditions for a restart, will issue new time cards which will have a restart time and restart Control Number.

The restart position within the field shall be at the discretion of the COC/R2C.

10.1.6 The organisers reserve the right to disallow restart on safety grounds or if the restart would interfere with the running of the rally.

10.2 Penalties:

10.2.1 Penalties will be applied as per Article 13.5, Appendix 29 of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook (as published on MI Website)

10.3 Award Eligibility:

10.3.1 In order to be classified as a finisher the crew must complete a minimum of 4 special stages, which must include the final loop of stages and the finish control.

10.3.2 Crews completing the rally under Rally 2 regulations will be eligible to score points in Championships.
