FINAL INSTRUCTIONS 1

1. All received entries have been accepted, thank you for supporting our event.
2. Please refer to the seeded entry list for your competition number. Please do not contact anyone regarding reseeding, all reseeding requests will be dealt with at recce sign on.
3. RECONNAISSANCE
 - a. Sign on times are as follows:
 - i. Saturday 29th March 08:00 – 11:00 or
 - ii. Friday 5th May 11:00 – 14:00
 - b. Sign on location is SHESKBURN GARAGE: 1 Glenshesk Road, Ballycastle, BT54 6QJ
 - c. All competitors will sign on for recce, the event and road risk insurance at recce sign on. Please ensure that you bring all required documentation **including competition licenses**.
 - d. Please be mindful of residents on all stages, observers will be in place on both allocated days. Anyone infringing on any reconnaissance regulations will be excluded from the event.
 - e. Note that due to a cycle race on Saturday 29th March there is to be no reconnaissance on Pollan or Ronan's Way between 10:00 – 11:00.
4. SCRUTINY
 - a. All scrutineering will take place on Friday 5th May at SHESKBURN GARAGE
 - b. Scrutiny times are as below:

 - c. It is essential that you have an OK/SOS board and spill kit in your car at all times, this will be checked at scrutiny.
 - d. In-car cameras must be fitted prior to scrutiny. Please note that in the event of a serious incident any camera footage must be immediately provided to the event organisers.
 - e. Time cards will be issued in documentation on receipt of your completed scrutiny card.
 - f. **Due to circumstances beyond our control there will no longer be a Parc Ferme after scrutiny.**

5. TRAILER PARK AND SERVICE AREA

- a. **No service vehicles are permitted in the service park until 9pm on Friday.** On arrival at the service area please park as instructed by the marshals. No servicing is allowed on the tarmac, please service on the gravel only and **remember a ground sheet must be used at all times.**
- b. Bin bags will be placed in each competitor pack, **PLEASE USE THEM!** We are privileged to have the use of such a good service area and want to ensure its use in the future.

6. EVENT START

- a. A Drivers Briefing will take place outside the GAC club house at 09:00 and **it is COMPULSORY THAT ALL** competitors attend.
- b. TCO is now service out. First car due is 10:00

7. EVENT FINISH

- a. **As there is a wedding party being held in the club house after the event we need to vacate the service park promptly and there will be no Parc Ferme.**
- b. There will be a champagne finish for the top 3 overall competitors outside the club house. All overall and class winners will receive a framed photograph by post after the rally.
