SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS.

Round 5 SW Adair 2017 ANICC MSA Sprint Championship.

- 1. The Enniskillen Motor Club Ltd will promote and organise a National ' B ' Permit Sprint on Saturday 1st July 2017 at St Angelo Enniskillen Co Fermanagh.
- 2. The meeting will be 'Held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA)', these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
- Motor Sports Association Permit Number TBA.
 Motor Sports Association Championship Permit Number CH2017/S088 (Grade E).
 Motor Sports Association Track Licence Number TBA.
- 4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the promoting club, or clubs affiliated to the ANICC, who are holders of Motor Sports Association or Motorsport Ireland licence valid for the event.
- 5. All competitors and drivers must produce a valid competition licence, and club membership card.
- 6. This event is a round of the 2017 ANICC Northern Ireland Sprint MSA Championship.
- 7. The programme of the meeting will be: Scrutineering starts at 06:30 hrs. Any competitor not signed on by 09:30 hrs may be excluded. Practice starts at 10:00 hrs. First Official run starts at 13:00 hrs. Finish venue is in the St Angelo Airport Restaurant in the Airport Main Building for prize giving. This will also be announced in final instructions on the Club's website.
- Awards will be presented as follows: 1st Overall – Trophy.

2nd Overall – Trophy.

3rd Overall – Trophy.

1st in Class – Trophy.

2nd in Class - Trophy (if more than 3 starters).

3rd in Class - Trophy (if more than 6 starters).

4th in Class – Trophy (if more than 9 starters).

- 11. The maximum entry for the meeting is 100. The minimum is 40. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected in order of receipt. Entry fees may be refunded if three days' notice is given. Dual Entries may be accepted at the organiser's discretion.

- 13. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event.
- 14. Protests should be lodged in accordance with Section C 5.
- 15. Starting order will be determined by Classes. Cars will start singly. The starting signal will be a GREEN LIGHT.

Timing will be automatic. The finish line will be indicated by finish boards and a white line across the road/track. A chequered flag will also be used as a finish signal.

- 16. Competitors will have the opportunity of two practice runs, having walked the course under official control, and three timed runs the fastest to count.
- 17. Competitors will be identified by side numbers complying with MSA Regulations, which will not be supplied by the Organisers.
- 18. All other General regulations of the MSA apply as written except the following, which are modified: -

TECHNICAL REGULATIONS: ALL CARS

Cars in all classes must comply with Sections J and S of the 2017 MSA Yearbook where appropriate.

Particular attention is drawn to Regulation J 5.1 which states:

"As a general principle in all Technical Regulations, it is prohibited to carry out any tuning or modification that is not specifically permitted. The fact that some modifications are mentioned as prohibited does not imply that others are allowed."

Vehicles that are not exclusively powered by an internal combustion engine are subject to the following regulations, those set out in (K) or SR's as appropriate. Electric and Hybrid vehicles must comply with FIA App J Article 253, Article 18, or be fully compliant with National Vehicle Type Approval.

19. CLASS DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of Championship scoring, vehicles will be divided into the following divisions and classes:

1. Road Going Series Production Cars up to 1700cc, 2WD only

2. Road Going Series Production Cars over 1700cc, 2WD only

3. Road Going Series Production Cars 4WD

4. Road Going Specialist Production Cars up to 2500cc, having no more than 2 valves per cylinder

5. All other Road Going Specialist Production Cars

6A. Modified Series Production Cars, 2 valve 2WD only

6B Modified Series Production Cars, multi valve 2WD only

7. Modified Specialist Production cars, 2WD only

8. Sports Libre Special Saloon Cars up to 1400cc, 2WD only.

9. Sports Libre Cars, 2WD only

10. Sports Libre Rally Cars up to 1650cc Multivalve and 2100cc 2V, 2WD only

- 11. Sports Libre Rally Cars over 1650cc Multivalve, and 2100cc 2V, 2WD only
- 12. All other 4WD Sports Libre Cars
- 13. Racing Cars complying with Formula VW or Club Formula Ford (FF1600)
- 14. Racing Cars up to 2000cc, having no more than 2 valves per cylinder or up to 1400cc multivalve

15. All other Racing Cars

16A. Road Going Historic Saloons and Sportscars

- 16B. Non Road Going Historic Saloons and Sports Cars.
- 17. Vintage and PVT as defined by UVCC

NOTES:

ALL VEHICLES IN CLASSES 1 – 17 MUST COMPLY WITH CURRENT MSA TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Forced induction will be considered as subject to a 1.4:1 engine capacity coefficient.

Cars entered in Classes 10 and 11 (Sports Libre Rally Cars) must be capable of passing scrutineering for a Nat. B status Stage Rally (Section R 2017 MSA Yearbook). Cars must be capable of passing an MOT but a Test Certificate or Road Fund Licence is not required. Registration documents must be available for inspection at scrutineering if requested.

All vehicles entered in Class 8 must be visually based on cars produced for road use and retaining the silhouette as seen in the side elevation

Definition of Historic Road Going Saloon and Sports Cars – Class 16

Cars based on a model in series production before 1 January 1974. Major components (cylinder head, engine block, gearbox casing, rear axle casing) must be of the original type. Period modifications may be permitted subject to written approval of the ANICC Speed Committee and the Championship Eligibility Scrutineer.

The Organising Club reserve the right to reclassify vehicles according to eligibility. The Organisers also reserve the right to have any vehicle examined with regard to Class eligibility and engine capacity

I acknowledge that I understand the nature and type of competition and the potential risk inherent with motor sport and agree to accept that risk.

I understand that motorsport can be dangerous and accidents causing death, injury, disability and property damage can and do happen. I understand that these risks may give rise to my suffering personal injury or other loss and I acknowledge and accept these risks."

"In consideration of the acceptance of this entry I agree that neither any one of or any combination of the MSA and its associated clubs, the organisers, the track owners or other occupiers, the promoters and their respective officers, servants, representatives and agents (the "Parties") shall have any liability for loss or damage which may be sustained or incurred by me as a result of participation in the Event including but not limited to damage to property, economic loss, consequential loss or financial loss howsoever caused. Nothing in this clause is intended to or shall be deemed to exclude or limit liability for death or personal injury. To the fullest extent permitted by law I agree to indemnify and hold harmless each of the Parties in respect of any loss or damage whatsoever and howsoever arising from my participation in the Event.
