Entries open to all drivers whom hold a current license and log book, which must be produced at scrutiny. Entries are open on publication of these regulations. Competitors will be excluded from the results for but not limited to the following offences.

- (i) Unofficial practice in any type of vehicle
- (ii) Failure to wear safety belt and crash helmet of the approved type while on the course.
- (iii) Failure to have the appropriate type fire extinguisher in the car at all times during the event.
- (iiii) Failure to pass scrutiny or to arrive at scrutiny after practice has begun.
- (v) Failure to obey a reasonable request from an official.
- (vi) Servicing outside of the designated service area.

A maximum of 3 drivers per car will be allowed but the onus will be on the competitors to have the correct competition number clearly displayed. The club accepts no responsibility for mistakes in timing due to the wrong number being displayed. There will be a minimum of 3 timed runs.

#### **CLASSES**

- 1 Saloons and Sports Cars up to 1450cc with engine over driven wheels.
- 2 Saloons and Sports Cars 1451cc to 1650cc with engine over driven wheels.
- 3 All other Saloons and Sports Cars to 1650cc.
- 4 Saloons and Sports Cars over 1651cc with engine over driven wheels.
- 5 All other Saloons & Sports Cars not qualifying for Class 1,2,3 & 4. Super Saloons & all 4WD Cars will run in this Class.
- 6 Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies over 600cc. Only open to competitors 18 Years and over.
- 7 Car Engined Specials. Only open to competitors 18 Years and over.
- 8 "Intermediate class" for 16-18 year olds, holding a "Speed National B" license in saloon cars up to 1650cc
- 9 "Junior Class" for 14-16 year olds holding a "Junior" License in Saloon Cars up to 1450cc.

10 Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies up to 600cc. Only open to competitors 18 Years and over.

The track will be marked with flags and arrows. A penalty of 5 seconds will be incurred for striking or passing on the wrong side of a standing Red marker. Claims for Baulking must be made at the end of the run in which it occurred. Dangerous driving and Unruly Behaviour will be dealt with by the COC. The official Timekeepers, Officials and Flag Marshall's will be Judges of Fact and will be deemed to be Correct at all times. The appropriate fee must accompany protests. Awards will be presented to FTD Saloon in Classes 1-4 Amalgamated; along with FTD in Class 5 Only (Super Saloons); and FTD Specials, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class and Ladies along with best TLC&MCC Driver. Other awards at the clubs discretion.
