2. The event is an open navigation trial held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland, including amendments published, these supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued before the start of the event

3. The event will be run according to the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland, Appendix 33 of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook, these supplementary regulations and any amendments of the standard regulations as published by MI.

4. Route

Approximately 85 miles in length. Petrol will be required to cover approximately 85 miles without refuelling. Controls and time points will define the route as well as vias which must be visited in the order stated.

9. CLASSES:

NOVICE - Any competitor, other than a Beginner, who first navigated on a Navigation/Retro Trial within 4 years of the commencement of the current season plus any competitor who has not been promoted.

SEMI-EXPERT - Any competitor not within the classification of a beginner, novice or expert.

EXPERT - Any navigator who has been placed in the top three in any Navigation Championship series in the past five years, plus any competitor who has been promoted or designated an expert by the Navigation Sub-Committee.

10. Entries close on Wednesday 22rd November 2017. Entry fee €75 excludes competitors personal accident insurance and IRDS (€130 including competitors personal accident insurance and IRDS at standard rate). All drivers must have a valid 2017 Competition Licence and 2017 IRDS Cover. Maximum number of starters is 50. Entries from FIA ASN INTERNATIONAL grade driver licence holders from abroad may be accepted in this event.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry or of my being permitted to take part in this event I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified the Skibbereen & District Car Club Ltd (Organising Club), Irish Automobile Club Ltd. t/a Royal Irish Automobile Club, Irish Motorsport Federation Ltd. t/a Motorsport Ireland, landowners and their respective officials, servants, representatives and agents from and against all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss of or

damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s) (as the case may be) howsoever caused arising out of or in connection with this entry or my taking part in this event and notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents. Furthermore, in respect of any parts of this event on ground where Third Party Insurance is not required by law, this Agreement shall in addition to the parties named above extend to all and any other competitor(s) and their servants and agents and to all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s).
