This will be an open Loose Surface Autocross to be held under the international sporting code of the FIA, the GCR'S of Motorsport Ireland including appendix "86 & 87" of the current Motorsport Ireland yearbook, these supplementary regulations. **Motorsport Ireland Permit No .18/113** has been issued for the event. The organizers have reserved the right to cancel or postpone the event or part of it in exceptional circumstances.

The event takes place in private property in Ballybeggan Racecourse, Tralee, Co. Kerry.

The event will be arrowed from approach roads in the Tralee area. Check-in will be at the venue.

1st timed run 10:30a.m.

Entries are open to all drivers whom hold a current competition licence and log book which must be produced at scrutiny. Since no part of the event takes place on public roads, cars need not comply with the requirements of the road traffic act, provided that such cars are not driven to the event.

Entries are open on publication of these regulations.

Competitors will be excluded from the results for the following offences:

- 1) Failure to wear safety belt and crash helmet of the approved type while on the course.
- 2) Failure to have appropriate type fire extinguisher in the car at all times during the event
- 3) Failure to pass scrutiny or to arrive at scrutiny after 1st timed run has begun.
- 4) Failure to obey a reasonable request from an official.
- 5) Use of spikes, studs, chains and altered tyre patterns.

Scrutiny Requirements.

All cars must pass scrutiny

All cars must carry seatbelt cutters.

All cars must be fitted with fire extinguishers of approved type

All cars must be fitted with full roll cage and have laminated windscreens.

All cars must be fitted with FIA approved seats.

Fire proof clothing must be worn as per MI regulations.

Overhead/roof skid pans and side netting are compulsory on specials.

Seats, safety belts and helmets of approved type must be used. See specification in current yearbook and latest MI bulletins.

Classes

Class 1: All Saloon cars up to 1450 c.c.

Class 2: All Saloon cars from 1451 c.c.to 1650 c.c. with not more than 2 valves per cylinder

Class 3: All Saloon cars from 1451 c.c.to 1650 c.c. with more than 2 valves per cylinder

Class 4: All Saloon cars from 1651 c.c.to 2100 c.c.

Class 5: All Saloon cars over 2100 c.c., 4WD cars and Turbocharged Saloon Cars.

Class 6: Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies over 601cc. Only open to competitors 18 years and over.

Class 7: Car Engined Specials. Only open to competitors 18 years and over.

Class 8: "Intermediate class" for 16 – 18 year olds, holding a "Speed National B license in saloon cars up to 1650cc.

Class 9: "Junior class" for 14 – 16 year olds, holding a "Junior" license in saloon cars up to 1450cc.

Class 10: Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies up to 600cc. Only open to competitors 18 years and over.

Ladies Class

N.B. All cars must run in their proper classes.

Awards

FTD will receive the Jimmy Devane Cup.

FTD Specials/Buggies & FTD Saloons, 1st, 2nd& 3rd in each class and Best

Newcomer. Winners of the overall awards will not be eligible for class awards.

Additional awards may be announced at the start.

Prize giving will take place in the Sheehans Bar Firies at 17:30.

Protests will only be accepted as per MI regulations. No case for force majeure will be considered once a competitor has started the event. Ties will be resolved in favour of the competitor with the smallest ccs.

Failing this, the fastest first run.

Final instructions may be issued at the start or during the course of the event if deemed necessary for safety reasons.

THE CLERK OF THE COURSE HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE AN ENTRY.
