Entries are open to all drivers whom hold a current competition license and log book which must be produced at scrutiny.

Entries are open on publication of these regulations

Competitors will be excluded from the results for the following offences.

- 1 Unofficial Practice in any type of vehicle.
- 2 Failure to wear safety belt and crash helmet of the approved type while on the course.
- 3 Failure to have appropriate type fire extinguisher in the car at all times during the event
- 4 Failure to pass scrutiny or to arrive at scrutiny after practice has begun.
- 5 Failure to obey a reasonable request from an official.

Scrutiny Requirements.

All competing vehicles must carry a Seat Belt Cutter.

All cars must pass scrutiny

All cars must be fitted with fire extinguishers of approved type

All cars must be fitted with full roll cage and have laminated windscreens.

All cars must be fitted with FIA approved seats.

Fire proof clothing must be worn as per MI regulations.

Overhead / roof skid pans and side netting are compulsory on specials.

Seats, safety belts and helmets of approved type must be used. See specification in current MI Yearbook and latest MI bulletins.

Multiple Drives:

☐ A maximum of three drivers will be permitted per competing car. Cars being double or treble driven MUST be sanitised when changing driver.

☐ Sharing of helmets, balaclavas, gloves or other equipment is not allowed due to Covid-19, except for family members living in the same household.

☐ Please co-operate with marshals and officials and stay in line with current

Social distancing guidelines in relation to Covid-19. Please remain with your vehicle while in the Service Area and do not congregate in groups around the Paddock.

☐ Please bring your own supply of PPE / disinfectant wipes / hand sanitizer etc for your own personal use.

☐ As per Appendix 86 9.8, Smoking is strictly prohibited in the Paddock or Service Area.

Penalties:

Penalties will be applied as per Appendix 86, Art. 2

<u>Please comply with the direction of marshals and officials who are there for your safety and protection regarding Covid-19. A Time penalty of 30 seconds will be applied to a competitor's fastest time of the day for failure to comply with directions or instructions relating to Covid-19.</u>

Classes.

Class 1: All saloon cars up to 1450cc

Class 2: All saloon cars from 1451cc to 1650cc with not morethan 2 valves per cylinder

Class 3: All saloon cars from 1451cc to 1650cc with more than 2 valves per cylinder

Class 4: All saloon cars from 1651cc to 2100cc

Class 5: All saloon cars 2101cc and over, all 4WD cars &all turbocharged saloon Cars.

<u>Class 6:</u> Motorcycle Engined Specials over 1250cc up to 1400cc Maximum. Only open to competitors 18 years and over.

Class 7: Car Engined Specials. Only open to competitors 18 years and over.

<u>Class 8:</u> Intermediate Class for 16-18 year olds, holding a Speed National B licence in Saloon cars up to 1650cc.

<u>Class 9:</u> Junior Class for 14-16 Year Olds holding a Junior Licence in Saloon cars up to 1450cc.

<u>Class 10:</u> Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies up to 600cc. Only open to competitors 18 years and over.

<u>Class 11:</u> Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies from 601cc to 1000cc. Only open to competitors 18 years and over

Class 12: Motorcycle Engined Specials 751cc to 1249cc. Only open tocompetitors 18 years and over.

Notes on Classes - Maximum Engine Capacities are as Follows: Motorcycle Engine Buggy is 1000cc, Motorcycle Engine Special is 1400cc, Car Engine Special is 4000cc.

Awards.

• Fastest time of the day for Buggy/Special, 4 WD Saloon and 2 WD Saloon •1st, 2nd& 3rd in each class, provided there are 5 or more entries in each class (otherwise classes may be amalgamated) NOTE: The overall winner, Buggy/Special, 4WD and 2-wheel drive winners are not eligible for class awards.
• Ladies award - Awarded to the highest placed lady not receiving any other award.
