Organisation

The event is organised and promoted by The Motor Enthusiasts' Club Limited, hereinafter called the promoters.

ENTRIES Entries on the completed entry form accompanied by the entry fee of €145, €135 for drivers aged 16 & 17) should be sent to: **Mr David Pain, 53 Dundela Park, Sandycove, Co. Dublin.** The entry fee includes the drivers Competitors' Personal Accident Insurance premium. Passengers must pay the Personal Accident Insurance premium of €15 (€8 persons aged 16 & 17).

IRDS

IRDS does not apply to this event.

EVENT

Approximate Length	:	1 Mile consisting of the Race and Rallycross tracks at Mondello Park, Naas, Co.Kildare.
Surface	:	Combination of Tarmac & Loose
Number of Runs	:	Minimum of 3 and maximum of 5, subject to <i>force majeure</i> .
Runs to Count	:	All times to count towards the final result.
Timing	:	Clocks

RESULTS

The results of the competition will be based on each competitor's cumulative time for the total number of runs completed and any penalties incurred.

TIMING

Timing will be to the nearest one hundredth of a second from a standing start to a flying finish. The 'Maximum Time' allowed to complete the stage is 10 minutes.

Times will be posted on the official notice board or other place specified by the organisers. The location of the official notice board will be advised at drivers briefing.

TIES

Ties will be resolved by reference to the fastest time on the last run and so on until the tie is resolved.

COMPETITORS

Double driving may be permitted and will be deemed to be separate entries. Separate entry forms must be completed and submitted. Passengers may be carried subject to their holding the appropriate competition licence (**ONE DAY LICENCES WILL BE AVAILABLE ON THE DAY FOR PASSENGERS ONLY**), signing an indemnity form and paying the Competitors Personal Accident Insurance fee. A driver must carry the same passenger for all the timed runs.

Class 1	All Group N Rally Cars
Class 2	All Group A Rally Cars
Class 3	Modified Rally Cars up to 1650cc
Class 4	Modified Rally Cars 1651cc to 2050cc
Class 5	Rallycross Cars up to 1650cc
Class 6	Rallycross Cars 1651cc to 2050cc
Class 7	Rallycross Cars over 2050cc
Class 8	All Modified Rally Cars over 2050cc
Class 9	All other Rally Cars
Class 10	Stock Hatch Rallycross Cars up to 1600cc

Classes may be amalgamated if less than five entries are received in a particular class or classes or the number or awards may be reduced.

PROTESTS

All protests must be as per the General Competition Rules.

PENALTIES

In addition to the penalties contained in the FIA International Sporting Code, the General Competition Rules, and the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook the following regulations will also apply.

1. Jump Start - 30 seconds
2. The following will carry the penalty of exclusion from the event:
 - a) Failing to report to the start when instructed to do so.
 - b) Not wearing safety clothing, helmet, or other equipment on the stage.
 - c) Overtaking between the flying finish and the stop point.
 - d) Driving in the opposite direction on the stage.
 - e) Servicing in a prohibited area.
 - f) Driving in a dangerous or reckless manner in the service/paddock area.
 - g) Carry a passenger other than that stated on the entry form.
3. The 'Maximum Time' will be given for:
 - a) Failing to complete the stage
 - b) Missing a timed run
