**National Autocross Championship.**

The event will be held under the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA). Appendix 85, 86 & 87 of the 2011 M.I Yearbook (Green Book), these supplementary regulations and any other final instructions that may be issued. M.I Permit No: 11-105.

**Venue: Philipstown, Crossakiel, Kells, Co. Meath. Signposted from Oldcastle, M3.**

The event will begin on Saturday: Scrutiny from 12 noon. Practice run at 2pm and the first timed runs at 3pm. Sunday Scrutiny from 10.30am, Practice at 11.30am and the first timed run at 12.30pm. Drivers briefing will be held after practice on both days.

Unofficial practice failure to pass scrutiny or late arrival will lead to exclusion. All cars must comply with appendix 2&3 of the 2011 M.I year book-Scrutiny requirements. A maximum of 3 drivers per car will be allowed but the onus will be on the competitors to have the correct competition number clearly displayed.

**CLASSES:**

1. Sports car & Saloons up to 1400cc with engine over driven wheels.
  1. a. Saloon cars up to 1000cc (to be reviewed after 1 year).
  2. a. Saloons and Sports Cars 1401cc to 1650cc with engine over driven wheels.
    2. b. All other Saloons and Sports Cars up to 1650cc
  3. a. Saloons and Sports Cars over 1650cc with engine over driven wheels.
    3. b. All other Sports Cars and Saloons not qualifying for classes 1, 2 & 3a.
  4. a. Specials, singles seaters, sports racing cars, all other motor cycle engine cars including 4WD cars up to 2100cc. Only open to competitors 18 yrs.
    4. b. Specials, Single Seaters and Sports Racing Cars including 4WD Cars over 2100cc.
  5. a. "Intermediate class" for 16-18 years old, holding a "Special National B" licence in saloon cars up to 1650cc
  5. b. Junior Class for 14-16 year olds holding a "junior" Licence in Saloon Cars up to 1400cc
  6. Optional class for club member's cars unlimited cc. This class is not eligible for championship award.

The track will be marked with flags and arrows. A penalty of 5 seconds will be incurred for striking or passing on the wrong side of a standing Red marker. Claims for Baulking must be made at the end of the run in which it occurred. Dangerous driving and Unruly Behaviour will be dealt with by the C.O.C. The official timekeepers, Officials and Flag Marshall's will be the Judges of Fact and will be deemed to be Correct at all times. The appropriate fee must accompany protests. Awards will be presented to FTD Saloons and Specials, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class and Ladies along with best C.A.C Driver on each day. Combined FTD to the Overall winner of saloons & specials for the 2 Days. Other awards at the clubs discretion.

The event will also be 1 round of the midget car racing club championship:

**Midget car racing awards as per MRCCI regulations.**

#### **Midget car racing drivers:**

Each driver must complete and return an entry form, two driver's entries will be accepted in respect of each car but it must be stated clearly on the entry form which races each driver will compete in. All drivers must present a current competition licence and medical certificate on demand.

### **Midget racing car marks as per M.R.C.C.I rules**

#### **Midget racing car – fence**

All drivers must attend to erect the fence before racing starts and to take down the fence when racing is over. **No driver is to leave venue until truck is loaded.**

**Midget racing car entry fee is: £85 per day.**
