10.30am SHARP (Check-in from 10.00 am). All drivers must hold a valid competition licence, which must be available for inspection at the start. *One day License's will be available on the day*.

<u>PENALTIES</u>: The time taken for each test will be the penalty for that test, with additional penalties as follows: each initial contact with a pylon: 5 seconds, each line fault: 5 seconds. The maximum loss (including failure) on any test will be the best correct performance in class plus 20 seconds.

NOTE THAT ALL LINES DURING A TEST MUST BE CROSSED BY A CAR'S LEADING WHEELS ONLY - i.e., STOP ASTRIDE ALL LINES. THERE IS A 5 SECOND PENALTY FOR PUTTING THREE OR FOUR WHEELS ACROSS A LINE.

Class E will be eligible for class award only and will not be eligible for overall position. No competitor may win more than one award.
