Class 3: All Saloon cars from 1651 c.c. to 2100 c.c.

Class 4: All Saloon cars 2101 c.c. and over, 4WD & Turbo Charged Saloon Cars.

Class 5: Car Engined Specials.

Class 6: Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies.

Class 7: Junior Class for 16 –18 Year Olds holding a Speed National B Licence in 2wd Saloon Cars up to 1650 c.c.
