NOVICE - Any competitor, other than a Beginner, who first navigated on a Navigation/Retro Trial within 4 years of the commencement of the current season plus any competitor who has not been promoted.

SEMI-EXPERT - Any competitor not within the classification of a beginner, novice or expert.

EXPERT - Any navigator who has been placed in the top three in any Navigation Championship series in the past five years, plus any competitor who has been promoted or designated an expert by the Navigation Sub-Committee.

Entry fee €70 excludes competitors personal accident insurance and IRDS (€120 including competitors personal accident insurance and IRDS at standard rate).
