The event takes place in private property in Nunstown, Aghadoe, Killarney,

Co. Kerry.

The event will be arrowed from Killarney.

Check-in will be at the venue.

1st timed run 12:30p.m.

Entries are open to all drivers whom hold a current competition licence and log book which must be produced at scrutiny. Since no part of the event takes place on public roads, cars need not comply with the requirements of the road traffic act, provided that such cars are not driven to the event.

#### Entries are open on publication of these regulations.

Competitors will be excluded from the results for the following offences.

Failure to wear safety belt and crash helmet of the approved type while on the course.

Failure to have appropriate type fire extinguisher in the car at all times during the event

Failure to pass scrutiny or to arrive at scrutiny after 1<sup>st</sup> timed run has begun.

Failure to obey a reasonable request from an official.

Use of spikes, studs, chains and altered tyre patterns.

#### Scrutiny Requirements.

All cars must pass scrutiny

All cars must be fitted with fire extinguishers of approved type

All cars must be fitted with full roll cage and have laminated windscreens.

All cars must be fitted with FIA approved seats.

Fire proof clothing must be worn as per MI regulations.

Overhead/ roof skid pans and side netting are compulsory on specials.

Seats, safety belts and helmets of approved type must be used. See specification in current yearbook and latest MI bulletins.

### Classes

- Saloon Cars up to 1450cc.
- 2 Saloon Cars from 1451cc to 1650cc.
- 3 Saloon Cars from 1651cc to 2050cc.
- 4 Saloon Cars 2051cc and over, 4 wheel drives.

- 5 Specials car engine.
- 6 Specials motorbike engine (including JB Racing Buggies).
- 7 Junior.
- 8 Ladies.

**N.B.** All cars must run in their proper classes.

#### **AWARDS**

1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class.

Juniors and Ladies must enter the appropriate class for their vehicle and if not eligible for an award in that class, will be eligible for a Junior award or Ladies award, as appropriate.

Winners of the overall award will not be eligible for class awards.

FTD will receive the Jimmy Devane Cup.

Additional awards may be announced at the start.

Prizegiving will take place in the venue after the event.

Protests will only be accepted as per MI regulations. No case for force majeure will be considered once a competitor has started the event. Ties will be resolved in favour of the competitor with the smallest ccs.

Failing this, the fastest first run.

Final instructions may be issued at the start or during the course of the event if deemed necessary for safety reasons.
