Motorsport Ireland Permit No. 18/110 issued for the event. The organisers have reserved the right to cancel or postpone the event or part of it in exception circumstances.

The event takes place in private property in Ballybeggan Racecourse, Tralee, Co. Kerry.
The event will be arrowed from approach roads in Tralee area.
Check-in will be at the venue.

Entries are open to all drivers whom hold a current competition licence and log book which must be produced at scrutiny. Since no part of the event takes place on public roads, cars need not comply with the requirements of the road traffic act, provided that such cars are not driven to the event.

ENTRIES ARE OPEN ON PUBLICATION OF THESE REGULATIONS

Competitors will be excluded from the results for the following offences:

- a) Failure to wear safety belt and crash helmet
- b) Failure to have appropriate type fire extinguisher in the car at all times during the event
- c) Failure to pass scrutiny or to arrive at scrutiny after 1st timed run has begun
- d) Failure to obey a reasonable request from an official
- e) Use of spikes, studs, chains and altered tyre patterns

Scrutiny Requirements:

All cars must pass scrutiny

All cars must carry seat belt cutters

All cars must be fitted with fire extinguishers of approved type

All cars must be fitted with full roll cage and have laminated windscreens

All cars must be fitted with FIA approved seats

Fire proof clothing must be worn as per M I regulations

Overhead/roof skid pans and side netting are compulsory on specials

Seat, safety belts and helmets of approved type must be used. See specification in current yearbook and latest M I bulletins

Classes

Class 1: All Saloon cars up to 1450cc

Class 2: All Saloon cars from 1451cc to 1650cc with not more than 2 valves per cylinder

Class 3: All Saloon cars from 1451cc to 1650cc with more than 2 valves per cylinder

Class 4: All Saloon cars from 1651cc to 2100cc

Class 5: All Saloon cars over 2100cc, 4WD cars and Turbocharged Saloon Cars

Class 6: Motorcycle engined specials including Buggies from 601cc to 750cc. Only open to competitors 18 years and over

Class 7: Car engined specials. Only open to competitors 18 years and over

Class 8: "Intermediate Class" for 16 – 18 year olds, holding a "Speed National B licence in saloon cars up to 1650cc

Class 9: "Junior Class" for 14 – 16 year olds, holding a "Junior" licence in saloon cars up to 1450cc

Class 10: Motorcycle engined specials including Buggies up to 600cc. Only open to competitors 18 year and over

Class 11: Motorcycle engined specials including buggies over 750cc. Only open to competitors 18 years and over.

N.B. All cars must run in their proper classes

Awards

FTD will receive the Jimmy Devane Cup

FTD Specials/Buggies & FTD Saloons, 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class

Also award for best Lady and best newcomer

Winners of the overall awards will not be eligible for class awards

Additional awards may be announced at the start

Prizegiving will take place at Ballybeggan Racecourse, after the event

Protests will only be accepted as per MI regulations.

No case for force majeure will be considered once a competitor has started the event. Ties will be resolved in favour of the competitor with the smallest cc's.

Failing this, the fastest first run.

Final instructions may be issued at the start or during the course of the event if deemed necessary for safety reasons.

THE CLERK OF THE COURSE HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE AN ENTRY
