

CAVAN STAGES RALLY 2019 Final Instructions No. 1

The Reserve list starts at number 132 and all entries including and above number 141 are placed on the reserve list and run consecutively thereafter. If you wish to withdraw your entry, please notify Nikki Sherlock on 086-600 3193 in order to facilitate other competitors.

Entry forms must be fully completed, and all other outstanding issues sorted before a competitor can start the shakedown stage.

Pace notes will be allowed on Saturday 25th May starting at 08.00 and finishing at 16.00. You must sign on for pace note making in the Rally Office at the Hotel Kilmore between 08.00 And 11.30. Please note a maximum of three passes per stage.

No trailers to be parked in the Hotel Kilmore car park or the entrance to the Hotel.

Co. Cavan Motor Club will not be liable for any damage incurred while removing trailers causing an obstruction.

Mechanical scrutiny and trailer park will take place in O'Neill Army Barracks, Dublin Road, Cavan. Scrutiny time is from 13.00 - 18.00.

On completion of Mechanical Scrutiny, Competitors who are taking part in the Shakedown stage must attend paper scrutiny in the Hotel Kilmore. Driver and navigator must attend paper scrutiny. All competitors must get a "SHAKEDOWN STAGE" stamp in rally office on completion of mechanical scrutiny if they wish to enter the shakedown stage.

Shakedown Stage will start at 16.30 on Saturday 25th May. A maximum of 3 runs over this non-timed stage. Service out will close at 18.30 for any competing cars that are doing the Shakedown Stage. All rally cars must be removed from service area to parc ferme.

Parc Ferme is located beside back car park off the Hotel Kilmore. Cars must be parked in Parc Ferme before 19.45. Parc Ferme will re-open on Sunday morning after Drivers briefing. Failure to do so will result in a 2-minute time penalty being added to your stage times.

Service area will be held in Liberty Insurance and Lakeland Dairies Car Park, Dublin Road, Cavan. We would ask that you respect the ground around your service area and leave it as you find it. The onus is on the competitor to have fire extinguishers displayed outside their service vehicles. Smoking is strictly prohibited in the service area.

Service area will open at 14.00 on Saturday. Service area will close at 18.00 on Sunday. No trailers to be parked in service area.

You will receive one service pass for the service area. You will not get into service without a service pass.

A Retirement Sticker with a Phone Contact Number will be issued with your door decals at Mechanical Scrutiny. This sticker <u>must</u> be displayed on your dashboard before entering Scrutiny and must remain there until the end of the event.

Drivers briefing will take place in the main function room of the Hotel Kilmore at 08.45 on Sunday morning.

ALL DRIVERS AND NAVIGATORS MUST ATTEND.

First car away from Parc Ferme will be at 9.55 on Sunday morning.

Competing cars will be permitted to carry advertising as per Appendix 2 article 14.1. Windscreen and windows shall bear no advertising, with the exception of a maximum 10cm high strip on the upper part of the windscreen, and, provided that this does not interfere with the visibility of the driver, an 8cm high strip on the rear window. GCR 187.2. Cars entered by residents of any part of the United Kingdom who hold MSA Competitor's Licences may carry advertising in accordance with MSA Rules when competing in events in Ireland held under MI permit.

Further instructions may be posted on the Rally Notice Board in the Rally Office and any information posted here will be deemed to have been read by all Competitors.
