Timetable: Check In: 8.30am.

Drivers Briefing: 9.45am. Tests Start: 10.00am.

<u>VERY IMPORTANT - INSURANCE</u>: All drivers with cars who do not comply with the Road Traffic Act <u>MUST</u> TRAILER the Car between the 2 Test Venues. NO IRDS REQUIRED.

<u>Format:</u> The event will consist of driving tests at 2 different locations. The onus is on the competitor to comply with the RTA. Navigators are NOT required-Passengers Allowed CPA €5 Extra (€3 if passenger is aged 16 or 17) – <u>MINIMUM AGE FOR PASSENGERS IS 16 YEARS</u>

Tests: Will be designed for Normal Production, Navigation Trial & Retro type Cars. 2WD Cars Only.

<u>Licence Requirements:</u> All Drivers must hold a valid **2019** competition licence, which must be available for inspection at Check In. One-Day Licences will be available.

<u>Penalties:</u> Failure to start at correct time when notified by the Marshals (Unless previously agreed with the COC) will result in a 5 Second Penalty per Minute late being applied.

The Time taken for each test will be the penalty for that test, with additional penalties as follows: each initial contact with a pylon: 5 Seconds, each line fault: 5 Seconds, failure to come to a complete stop (box) 5 Seconds, failure to attempt to stop (box) max penalty. The maximum loss (including failure) on any test will be the best correct performance overall plus 30 Seconds.

Note: THAT ALL LINES DURING A TEST MUST BE CROSSED BY A CAR'S LEADING WHEELS ONLY – i.e., STOP ASTRIDE ALL LINES.

THERE IS 5 SECOND PENALTY FOR PUTTING THREE OR FOUR WHEELS (or only ONE) ACROSS A LINE.

Entry Fee: €85 including CPA Insurance. Cheques payable to Birr & District Motor Club Ltd.

Classes:

- Front Wheel Drive Cars up to and including 1300cc.
- 2 Front Wheel Drive Cars from 1301cc to 1400cc.
- 3 Front Wheel Drive Cars over 1401cc.
- 4 Rear Wheel Drive Cars

The onus is on the driver to ensure that He/She is entered into the correct class. Ties will be decided by the better time on test 1, and so on. No more than 2 Drivers will be allowed per car. Where 2 Drivers are sharing a car, both names must shown on the entry form

<u>Cars:</u> <u>ONLY 2WD & NON-TURBOCHARGED CARS ARE ALLOWED.</u> The Tests will be designed to suit everyone. Test will be of a open nature. <u>Use of Seatbelts are compulsory.</u>

Tyres: No "Competition Use" branded, "Knobblies" M + S & Agricultural Tyres allowed on driven wheels.

Random Checks WILL be carried out. Anyone in any doubt as to what type of tyres may be used should contact the Clerk of the Course in advance to prevent any misunderstanding on the day.

<u>Awards:</u> 1st Overall & 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each Class. Best Ladies & BADMC Award. Additional Awards may be presented at the discretion of the Club.
