Unofficial practice, failure to pass scrutiny or late arrival will lead to exclusion. All cars must comply with appendix 2 of the 2019 M.I Yearbook-Scrutiny requirements. A maximum of 3 drivers per car will be allowed but the onus will be on the competitors to have the correct competition number clearly displayed. The club accepts no responsibility for mistakes in timing due to the wrong number being displayed.

- 1 Saloons and Sports Cars up to 1450cc with engine over driven wheels.
- 2 Saloons and Sports Cars 1451cc to 1650cc with engine over driven wheels.
- 3 All other Saloons and Sports Cars to 1650cc.
- 4 Saloons and Sports Cars over 1651cc with engine over driven wheels.
- All other Saloons & Sports Cars not qualifying for Class 1,2,3 & 4. Super Saloons & all 4WD Cars will run in this 5
- 6 Motorcycle Engined Specials over 1250cc up to 1400cc Maximum. Only open to competitors 18 years and over.
- 7 Car Engined Specials. Only open to competitors 18 Years and over.
- 8 "Intermediate class" for 16-18 year olds, holding a "Speed National B" licence in saloon cars up to 1650cc
- "Junior Class" for 14-16 year olds holding a "Junior" Licence in Saloon Cars up to 1450cc. 9
- 10 Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies up to 600cc. Only open to competitors 18 Years and over.
- Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies 601cc to 1000cc. Only open to competitors 18 Years and over. 11
- 12 Motorcycle Engined Specials 751cc to 1249cc. Only open to competitors 18 Years and over.

Notes on Classes: Maximum Engine Capacities are as follows: Motorcycle Engined Buggy is 1000cc, Motorcycle Engined Special is 1400cc, Car Engined Special is 4000cc.

The track will be marked with flags and arrows. A penalty of 5 seconds will be incurred for striking or passing on the wrong side of a standing Red marker. Claims for Baulking must be made at the end of the run in which it occurred. Dangerous driving and Unruly Behaviour will be dealt with by the COC. The official Timekeepers, Officials and Flag Marshall's will be Judges of Fact and will be deemed to be Correct at all times. The appropriate fee must accompany protests. Awards will be presented to FTD Saloon in Classes 1-4 Amalgamated; along with FTD in Class 5 Only (Super Saloons); and FTD Specials/Buggies.1st, 2nd & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class and Ladies along with best WDMC Driver. Other awards at the clubs discretion.
