SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1. A multi-venue autotest is being organised by Classic & Autotest Motorclub LTD on Saturday 28th September 2019 starting at Temple Golf Club, 60 Church Road, Lisburn, BT27 6UP.
- 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) these Supplementary Regulations and any other written instructions that the club may issue.
- 3. The event is open to all fully elected members of Peak Performance Motor Club, Autotest Drivers Club, Ballynahinch Motor Club, MG Car Club, M.I.N.I, Police Motor Club NI, Thoroughbred Sports Club and Trials Drivers Club.
- 4. All competitors must produce a valid membership card.

Signing on and scrutineering 8.30 am
Drivers briefing 9.45 am
First car starts at 10.00 am

5. The event will consist of the following classes:-

CLASS 1: All FWD cars under 11ft 8" CLASS 2: All FWD cars over 11ft 8" CLASS 3: All RWD cars under 1500 cc CLASS 4: All RWD cars over 1500 cc

- 6. The maximum entry is 45 and the minimum is 10. If any class is not achieved, the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes. The organisers have the right to cancel the event, refuse an entry or re-classify an entrant.
- 7. All competing cars must be mot'd, taxed and be roadworthy as per M17.1 (MSA Yearbook) and sign a declaration at signing on to this effect. All cars to be fully insured to comply with the Road Traffic Act 1988/91 and competitors must have a current full driving licence. NO HIRE CARS ALLOWED. THERE WILL BE NO COMPETING OR TIMED SECTIONS ON THE PUBLIC HIGHWAY BETWEEN VENUES.
- 8. PASSENGERS CAN BE CARRIED BETWEEN VENUES BUT MUST NOT BE IN CAR DURING ACTUAL TEST.
- 9. Autotest rules: You can only use tyres from list 1A as per MSA. Contact organisers if you have any queries.
- 10. All competing cars should carry a spill kit and warning triangle and a number will be issued at signing on.
- 11. Competitors are also reminded of noise limits as per MSA Regulations J5.17.1-8.
- 12. Details of tests and road book will be issued at signing-on. PRACTISING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AND MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION. Walking of tests will be allowed at 1st visit to test site only unless weather conditions change and each test will be completed twice.
- 13. Timing will be by hand held stopwatch to the nearest 0.10 second. The starting signal will be verbal and where

possible the order of attempting tests should be numerical.

- 14. Penalties will be as follows as per MSA Yearbook Table M.7:-
 - A. Striking pylons/cones 5 seconds.
 - B. Line Fault 5 seconds.
 - C. Not performing a test correctly (unless competitor corrects themselves from point in which they deviated from test diagram) will be given a FAIL (fastest in class + 20 seconds).
- 15. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that their name, car and class all appear on their timecard and that it is kept legible and in fair condition.
- 16. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event, and a copy will be posted on club website.
- 17. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with MSA Regulation C.5.1 5.7.
- 18. Entries must be made on official entry form accompanied by the appropriate fee of £50 which will include a bacon bap and tea/coffee and also lunch for drivers. Additional tickets can be purchased for £10. Dual entries permitted but must be in the same class MSA Regulation D.17.1 and D.17.1.1. In the event of over subscription of entries preference will be given to those who have completed entry form and have fully paid.
