1. Entries

Entries open on publication of these regulations and close on 16th October 2019.

CREW: Both crew members must hold (and produce) a current competition licence issued by their ASN.

VERY IMPORTANT - INSURANCE: All drivers must be listed on the current IRDS (MI licence holders) or BRDS scheme listing (MSA licence holders) on www.motorsportireland.com

There are no exceptions to this requirement. * NO LISTING, NO START *****

The entry fee is as follows: **€230** which includes IRDS/BRDS insurance premium and competitors personal accident insurance, less €7 reduction in CPA for any competitor aged 16 or 17. **Total Entry amount Due: €230**
Entry Forms must be fully completed and accompanied by fee of €230 made payable to Birr & District Motor Club Ltd.

Alternatively, you can make a bank transfer of €230 to our account, (Reference = DRIVERS NAME) but you must submit the entry form and proof of bank transfer to be included as a valid entry.

2. Classes

The event will have Seven classes as follows:

Class A1: Cars built to Endurance Specification up to 1000cc

Class A2: Cars built to Endurance Specification between 1001 and 1400cc

Class B: Navigation Trial Cars up to 1400 cc

Class C: Navigation Trial Cars from 1401 to 2000 cc

Class D: Front Wheel Drive Retro type cars

Class E: Rear Wheel Drive Retro type cars

F: All Sports Cars *

* *All MX5 roofs must be of a steel form, either bolted or stitch welded to the bodywork.*

The Overall Winner will be decided from Class A1 and A2 (Endurance Class) Competitors Only

Tyres for Endurance Events:

1. The Starmaxx Ice Gripper tyre W810 and the Sunny Winter Grip SN3860 are the navigation sub committee approved control tyres for the driven wheels in the Endurance Classes A1 and A2 only.
2. Tyres are free in all other classes, as long as they comply with Appendix 35 21.14, (which prohibit the use of any tyre with an 'Open' tread which might lead to damage to the private lanes used) or tyres marked 'For competition use' or anything similar. The Scrutineers decision on this will be final. (An exception to this rule would be to allow the Yokohama A021R tyre in the historic classes only, even if marked 'For competition use', due to the unavailability of a suitable tyre for cars in these classes)

3. Awards

- **General Classification:** 1st; 2nd; 3rd Overall (Combined from A1 and A2)
- **Class Awards:** 1st; 2nd; 3rd in each Class
 - Class A1: No Sub Division
 - Class A2: Will be divided into * Master / Expert / Semi Expert / Novice / Beginner
 - Class B & C: No Sub Division
 - Class D, E & F: No Sub Division

The Overall Winner will be decided from Class A1 and A2 (Endurance Class) Competitors Only

ELIGIBILITY FOR AWARDS:

Those receiving awards for overall placing will not be eligible for class awards.

The Organisers reserve the right to re-classify a competitor considered ineligible for a class, and /or amalgamate as required.

Classification will be based on the performance of the Driver and not the Navigator.

<i>Master</i>	This class qualification is: Finishing in the first three overall in an Endurance Trial or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or winning any event, except a Navigation Trial /Rally, promoted under an MSA or MI Permit.
<i>Expert</i>	This class qualification is: Finishing in the first six overall in an Endurance Trial or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or winning any event, except a Navigation Trial/ Rally, promoted under an MSA or MI Permit
<i>Semi Expert</i>	This class qualification is: Finishing in the first fifteen overall in an Endurance Trial or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, promoted under an MSA or MI Permit
<i>Novice</i>	This class qualification is: No class wins in an Endurance Trial or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or any event promoted under an MSA or MI Permit
<i>Beginner</i>	First year of Endurance Trials or Targa Rallies

4. General Route: Organisers will use only 1:50,000 maps: A map of the route will be provided. OS Map: Sheets 53/ 54 refer.

5. Penalties: As per Appendix 35 of the 2019 Motorsport Ireland Yearbook.

6. SCRUTINY REQUIREMENTS – ALL VEHICLES.

DECLARATION OF INDEMNITY

(a) I have read the supplementary regulations issued for this event and agree to be bound by them and by the General Competition Rules and Regulations of MI including the guidelines and regulations contained in Motorsport Ireland's Code of Conduct for Children's Sport. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry or of my being permitted to take part in this event I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified the Birr & District Motor Club Limited (Organising Club), Irish Automobile Club Ltd. t/a Royal Irish Automobile Club, Irish Motorsport Federation Ltd. t/a Motorsport Ireland and their respective officials, servants, representatives and agents from and against all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s) (as the case may be) howsoever caused arising out of or in connection with this entry or my taking part in this event and notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents. Furthermore, in respect of any parts of this event on ground where Third Party Insurance is not required by law, this Agreement shall in addition to the parties named above extend to all and any other competitor(s) and their servants and agents and to all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s).
