Recce Sign -On

- Rally office will be in the Ballybrit Suite, Clayton Hotel, Ballybrit, Galway on Friday 31st January 2020 between 19.00 hrs – 21.00 hrs Saturday 1st February 2020 between the hours of 08.30 hrs - 12:30 hrs
- Please make sure that you have your entry form completed correctly and signed by both driver & navigator before you approach the sign on desk

Recce

 Pace note making takes place on Saturday 1st February between 9am and 5pm. Please respect the residents on the stages and obey the 40kph speed limit. Last admission into any stage is 4.30pm. A maximum of three passes only per stage.

Licence / IRDS

- Both driver and co-driver must produce current competition licences at recce sign on.
- Please ensure that driver has current IRDS / BRDS in time for Documentation Scrutiny and that it is listed on the Motorsport Ireland database.

Mechanical Scrutiny / Trailer Park & Parc Ferme

- Trailer Park is Located in Yard beside Walsh Waste Deerpark, Oranmore Eire Code H91 RH31
- Mechanical Scrutiny will take place in Motor World, Station Road, Oranmore <u>Eire Code H91 FK59</u> from 1.00pm until 5.00pm on Saturday 1st February 2020
- Parc Feirme is located in the Car Park behind Caulfield's Oranmore Business Park, Eirecode H91 T27C

It is important that all cars use the following procedure when unloading competition cars for scrutiny:

- 1. You must proceed directly to the unloading area as directed by a marshal.
- 2. After unloading the rally car, you will be directed as to when to bring the car to mechanical scrutiny by a marshal.
- **3.** After Mechanical Scrutiny, the car must then be driven directly to Parc Ferme.
- **4.** Both crew members must attend documentation scrutiny in the Ballybrit Suite, Clayton Hotel after Scrutiny.

Mechanical Scrutiny takes place from 13.00hrs – 17.00hrs. Documentation Scrutiny will close at 19.30hrs sharp. STRICTLY NO SCRUTINY ON SUNDAY MORNING

Rule Change to Appendix 2, Article 28.2 – Fuel Sampling

A recent rule change passed by the Motorsport Council (MSC) has made it mandatory for cars competing in Motorsport Ireland speed events (Autocross, Rallycross, Rally Sprints, Racing, Special Stage Rallying, Sprints and Hill Climbs) to allow fuel sampling.

The specific wording of the rule change is provided below for your information and is included in the 2020 Motorsport Ireland Yearbook which will be published shortly.

28.2. Fuel.

Petrol or Diesel in compliance with FIA Appendix J Art 252, Article 9 (Petrol Max 102 octane).

With the exception of cars competing in road going production category, cars competing in Motorsport Ireland speed events (Autocross, Rallycross, Rally sprints, Racing, Special Stage Rallying, Sprints and Hill Climbs) it must be possible to take a fuel sample. For fuel injected cars the facility must be a dry break fuel sampling coupling, approved by the FIA.

For all others an appropriate fitting to allow fuel sampling must be present. In addition, competitors must carry and make available a 600mm minimum length of hose to which, where necessary, the appropriate mating part is to be attached. Cars must have sufficient fuel for a fuel test at any time during an event. Minimum volume required is 3.5 litres.
