

Timing in the event of a cancelled Run.

The event has planned to run 6 runs of the stage with timing for all runs to count.

In the event the organisers decide to cancel a run and not all competitors are offered the opportunity to complete said run, then all competitors will receive a stage maximum time, regardless of whether they have completed the run or not.

Scrutineering.

Scrutineering will be organised on a non-contact basis, competitors will be required to submit an online scrutineering sheet by Thursday 22nd of July. This is to allow faster scrutineering on the day by allowing logbooks etc to be checked before the event. (Note: - the actual logbook must still be available on the day of the event)

On the day of the event competitors will present their cars to the scrutineering queue as normal and then hold their overalls, helmets to show the scrutineer the relevant labels. After Scrutineering cars will return to their service area.

Finalise your entry

We have a number of incomplete entries, please complete your entry details as we will need to ensure that you are able to complete your declarations online in advance of the event, If you are unsure, can't figure out how to do online payments or have any other queries please contact the event secretary – don't leave it to the last minute as we will not be able to accommodate last minute requests. Access to the event venue on the day.

All are reminded that there is very limited access to the venue and the event. The event organisers are subject to a strict maximum number of personnel on site and do not have the discretion to depart from this.

Please note that all personnel entering the venue on the day will have to have completed a covid and normal MI signing on Indemnity in the days before the event. These pre-vent declarations will be used to create a list of personnel who will be allowed to access the venue on the day. **IF YOUR NAME ISNT ON THE LIST YOU WILL BE REFUSED ENTRY ON THE DAY.**

To ensure that you are able to complete the required online declaration in advance of the event you need to provide a valid email address to the organisers before Monday 18th July. This can be done in the following ways:
