To be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland Standard & Regulations for all Non-Championship Autocross Events, Appendix 86 & 87 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook and these Supplementary Regulations, The event is organized and promoted by Co. SCHEDULE:

- Entries open on publication of these regulations
- Entries close: Wednesday 9/11/22

Entries will be limited to a maximum of 60, if more than 60 entries are received, a reserve list will operate on a first come / first served basis

- **ENTRY FEE €110** (Including €15 Drivers Personal Accident Insurance)
- Entry Fee for Junior Section €80 (Including €8 Drivers Personal Accident.

A Competitor who wishes to withdraw their entry before the event, must contact the event secretary on or before Friday prior to the event otherwise their entry fee will **NOT** be returned.

- **No Practice after Official Timed Run has started**

ORGANISATION:

- All Drivers must be in possession of a valid competition license of the correct grade & vehicle logbook.
- Competitors are asked to stay with their own vehicle at scrutiny.
- All competitors must have the labels on their safety gear / racing suits showing and ready for inspection at scrutiny to avoid any unnecessary handling.
- All competition cars / buggies must pass scrutiny as per Appendix 2 of the current MI Yearbook
- As per Appendix 86 9.8, Smoking is strictly prohibited in the Paddock or Service Area.
- Mud flaps are obligatory on all wheels for each Run.
- No Slick tyres or modifying Slick tyres.

CLASSES:

- Class 1: All cars up to 1450cc (2 valves per cylinder)
- Class 2: All cars up to 1450cc (more than 2 valves per cylinder)
- Class 3: Cars from 1451cc to 1650cc (2 valves per cylinder)
- Class 4: Cars from 1451cc to 1650cc (more than 2 valves per cylinder)
- Class 5: Cars from 1651cc to 2050cc (2 valves per cylinder)
- Class 6: Cars from 1651cc to 2050cc (more than 2 valves per cylinder)
- Class 7: Specials & Buggies up to 650cc
- Class 7A: Specials & Buggies 651cc
- Class 8: Juniors. Cars up to 1650cc only. Must be under 21 before 1st Jan 2020
- Class 8a: Juniors. Saloon Cars up to 1450cc for 14 – 16 year olds holding a Junior Speed License.
- Class 9: J1000 Class for holders of Junior “Rally” or Junior “Speed” grade licences with cars complying to J1000 Technical Regulations as published on Motorsport Ireland website. Co-drivers are compulsory and must hold a minimum of a National B Competition Licence and be 21 years or over. Co-drivers are not allowed to be an entrant in the event in another class. No sharing of co-drivers is permitted

All CARS MUST BE ENTERED IN CORRECT CLASS

DOUBLE DRIVING:

- Double driving will be allowed.
- Double drivers and re-runs must wait a minimum of 2 timed runs before re-entering the track.

PENALTIES:

- Any competitor found SPEEDING in the paddock – 5 Second Penalty, 2nd Offence – Exclusion.
- Five seconds for striking a barrel, or passing on the wrong side of a marker.

AWARDS:

Fastest time of Any 3 Runs out of 5, added together for results (if weather or daylight does not allow for 5 runs, best 3 out of 5 will be for results, this will be announced at Drivers briefing).

- Overall Award for Cars = Trophy, and 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class
- Overall Award for Buggies & Specials = Trophy, and 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class
